Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated the 15th October, 1968 on the above subject addressed to the Chairman, Union Public Service Commission and to say that the Associate Membership Examination of the Indian Institute of Metals, Calcutta, has been recognised by the Government of India vide Ministry of Education, O.M. No.F.18/91/61-T dated the 2nd April, 1964 (copy enclosed). Persons who have passed the Associate Membership Examination of the Indian Institute of Metals, Calcutta are therefore considered by the Commission as eligible for purposes of recruitment to superior posts for which a Degree in Metallurgy is the prescribed qualification. It may, however, be stated that the practice of the Commission is to mention only the basic educational qualifications in their advertisements with a provision that persons with equivalent qualification are also eligible.
